



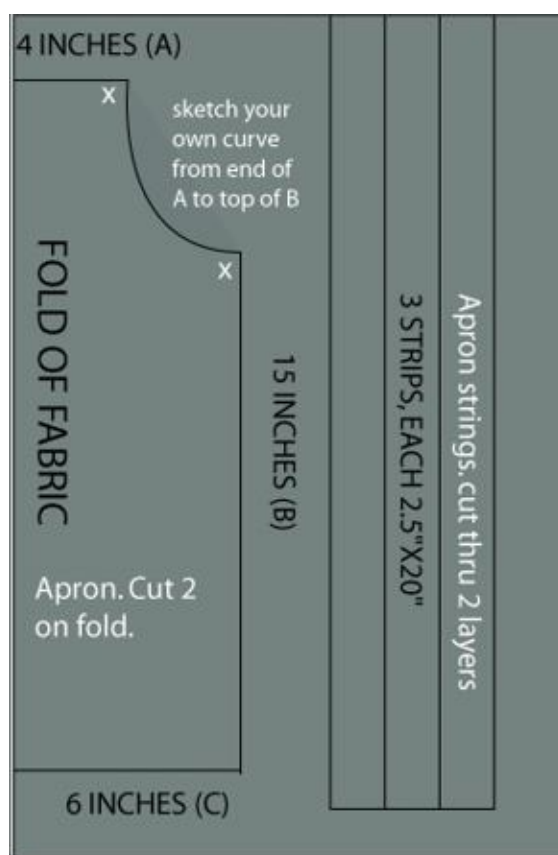

Embroidery Club

Children's Apron

Cut the fabric as shown in the diagram for the body of the apron and the ties.

- Cut 1 additional piece of fabric 12" x 10" for the pocket
- Mark a line through the center of the pocket dividing the piece into two 5" x 12" sections.
- Mark a line ½" up from the bottom of one long edge, denoting the seam allowance
- Mark another line halfway between the seam allowance and center lines. This marks the center placement for the embroidery designs.
- Select the embroidery designs to be used (pick 2 or 3 designs).
- Mark the center point, along the line, for each of the designs and stitch them.



- Fold the pocket in half along the centerline, wrong sides together, and baste it to the body of the apron.
- Make the apron strings by folding the fabric in half lengthwise and sewing along one line and one short end. Turn right side out to complete. Make 2.
- make the apron neck ring by folding the fabric in half lengthwise and sewing along the long edge. Turn right side out to complete. Make 1.
- Baste the neck tie in place along the top edge of the apron.
- Baste the side ties in place
- Place the two body fabrics right sides together making sure the pocket and ties will be caught in the seam.
- Start sewing at one neck tie and sew around the complete apron, stopping after sewing the the second edge of the neck tie. This will leave an opening at the center of the neck to turn the apron right side out.
- Top stitch the neck edge closed.
- Top stitch a ¼" in from the edge along all edges of the apron.
- Optionally stitch a line between each of the embroidery designs, through all layers, to create smaller pockets.
